37,000 times to the moon and back: fascinating facts from eight years of easyJet in Berlin

Rising passenger numbers

In 2010, the airline counted 3.2 million Berlin customers; in 2011, this number rose to 3.7 million. Over 23 million passengers have flown with easyJet from Berlin since 2004. Statistically, this means that every person in Berlin flies easyJet once a year.

Economic factor

Around 300 people work for easyJet in Berlin. Of all the airlines based in Berlin, the airline has the third-largest market share.

Top destinations from Berlin

easyJet flies to 35 destinations in Europe and North Africa from Berlin; in June 2012 a further two destinations will be added: the Greek islands of Rhodes and Mykonos.

Favourite destinations

easyJet's top destinations from Berlin are London, Barcelona, Paris, Rome and Basle.

An impressive distance

easyJet aircraft have already flown a total of 30 billion kilometres from Berlin, the equivalent of flying 37,000 times to the moon and back. The number of hours flown since 2004 is 41,430,112, which is nearly 4,730 years – almost as long as the entire history of Egypt.

Lightweights

Four in five passengers check in with hand luggage only. On average, these small cases weigh eight kilograms each.

Favourite drink

easyJet passengers who get thirsty high up in the sky prefer beer to other beverages. The number one savoury snack choice is crisps, while chocolate muffins are the most popular sweet choice.

A thirst for coffee

In the last eight years, easyJet passengers have drunk 61,000 litres of coffee on flights from Berlin. That's enough to fill more than 380 bathtubs.
