Important Information

If you are entering Germany from a non-EU country, the goods you are carrying, which do not exceed certain quantity and value limits, can be brought into Germany tax/duty-free if they meet the following conditions.

1. You are carrying the goods

Goods are considered to be "carried by the traveler" if they are imported using the same route as the traveler.

2. The goods are for your personal use or consumption

The goods are intended exclusively for your personal use or consumption, for members of your household, or as a gift. Goods that you import for others and receive compensation for, are excluded.

Restrictions on quantities and value

1. Tobacco products, if the importer is at least 17 years old:

- a) 200 cigarettes **or**
- b) 100 cigarillos **or**
- c) 50 cigars **or**
- d) 250 grams tobacco **or**
- e) a proportionate combination of these goods.

2. Alcohol and beverages containing alcohol, if the importer is at least 17 years old:

- a) 1 liter of alcoholic beverages containing alcohol of more than 22 % vol. **or**
undenatured ethyl alcohol with 80 % vol. or higher
- or**
- b) 2 liters of alcohol and alcoholic beverages containing alcohol of 22 % vol. or less or
a proportionate combination of these goods
- and**
- c) 4 liters of non-sparkling wine
- and**
- d) 16 liters of beer

3. Medical products

the quantity required for the traveler's personal needs

4. Other goods (like clothing, jewelry, computer, camera, etc.)

up to a value of 430 euro for air/sea travelers

up to a value of 175 euro for travelers under the age of 15

You have to declare all goods you are bringing with you, that are exceeding the travelers' allowance **or** are imported for commercial purposes **or** which are subject to restrictions or bans (like weapons, protected animals/plants, food).
